

Lesson Plan: Using FAST to Identify Student Learning Needs

Description:	This set of activities is designed to support teachers' use of FAST data to identify student learning needs. It will help teachers navigate FAST reports to determine specific skill needs for the purposes of targeting instruction.
Learning Objectives:	<p>Participants will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Use FAST reports to match classwide instructional needs. B. Explore FAST reports to match small group instructional needs. C. Explore FAST reports to match individual student instructional needs.
Tools Provided	<p>To support educators in using this module, it includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. A primary video. This will be used by the team while completing the module. B. A slide deck that may be viewed and used after the completion of the module. C. Activity documents that will be used during and after the completion of the module.
Recommended Team:	It is recommended that grade level teams, including specialists, complete this module together.
Time Requirement:	<p>This module is expected to take the grade level team approximately 2 hours to complete, and could be chunked if needed.</p> <p>This module may be used at any point in the school year.</p>

Data Needed:	<p>Screening to Intervention Report Detailed Group Report Group Skills Report Individual Skills Report</p>
Additional Information:	Although this module can be used at any point in the year, teams may find it most useful to use after they have explored their data using the Group Screening Report and/or Class List.
