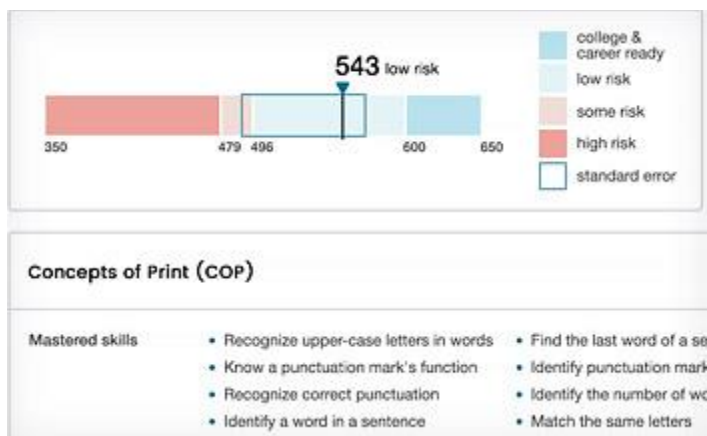


## Individual Skills Report: Overview
