

Lesson Plan: Examining Student Improvement in FAST

<p>Description:</p>	<p>This set of activities is designed to support teachers' use of FAST to identify class and student performance and growth. It supports the use of FAST data for identify class and student needs. And, it will help teachers analyze student growth across the school year.</p>
<p>Learning Objectives:</p>	<p>Participants will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Examine FAST reports to identify students who are at-risk in reading and math. B. Use FAST reports to analyze student growth throughout the year. C. Use the FAST progress monitoring report to reflect on growth trajectories.
<p>Tools Provided:</p>	<p>To support educators in using this module, it includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. A primary video. This will be used by the team while completing the module. B. A slide deck that may be viewed and used after the completion of the module. C. Activity documents that will be used during and after the completion of the module.
